



Reception did lots of Autumnal art on Art Day. We printed leaves on trees, mixed colours to make round autumn trees and then hand printed owls!



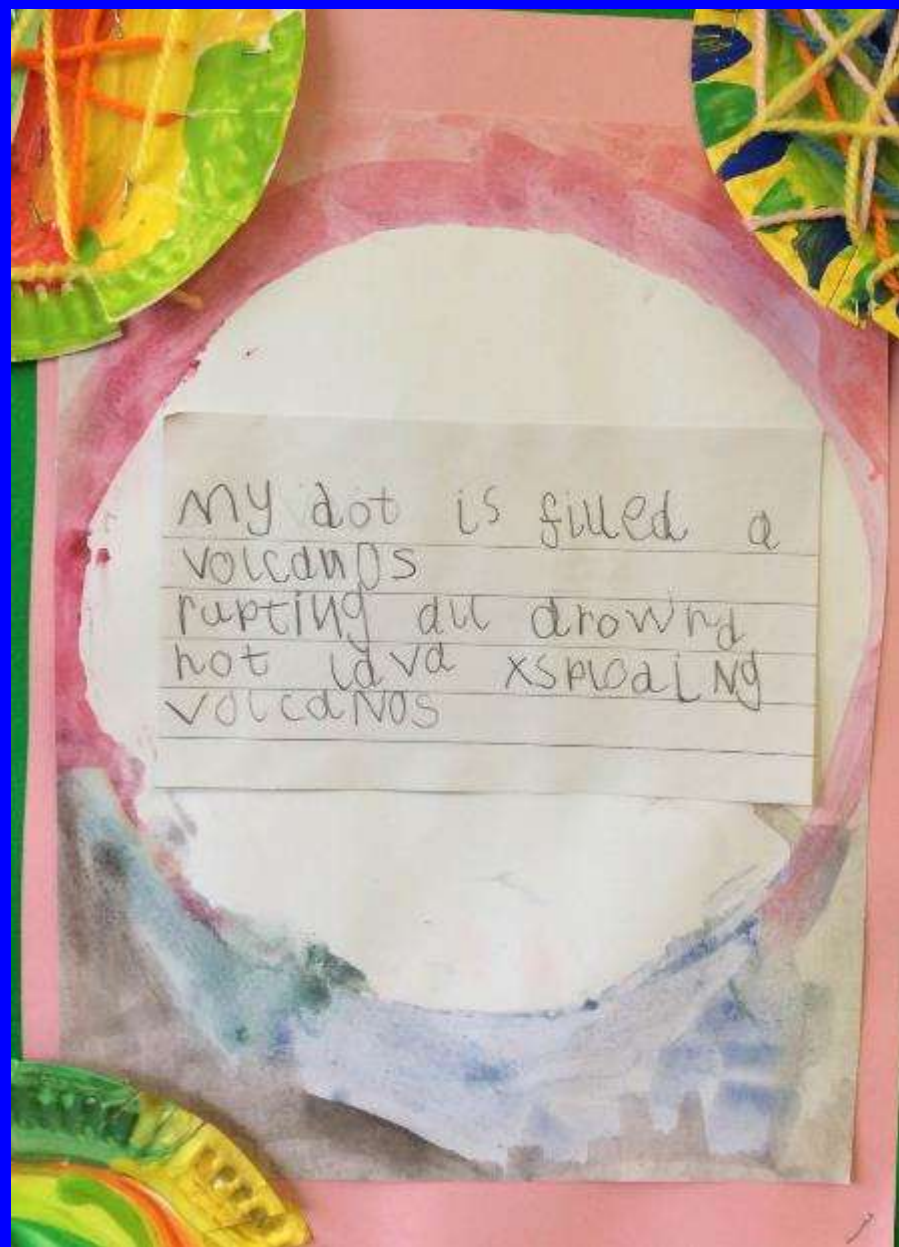
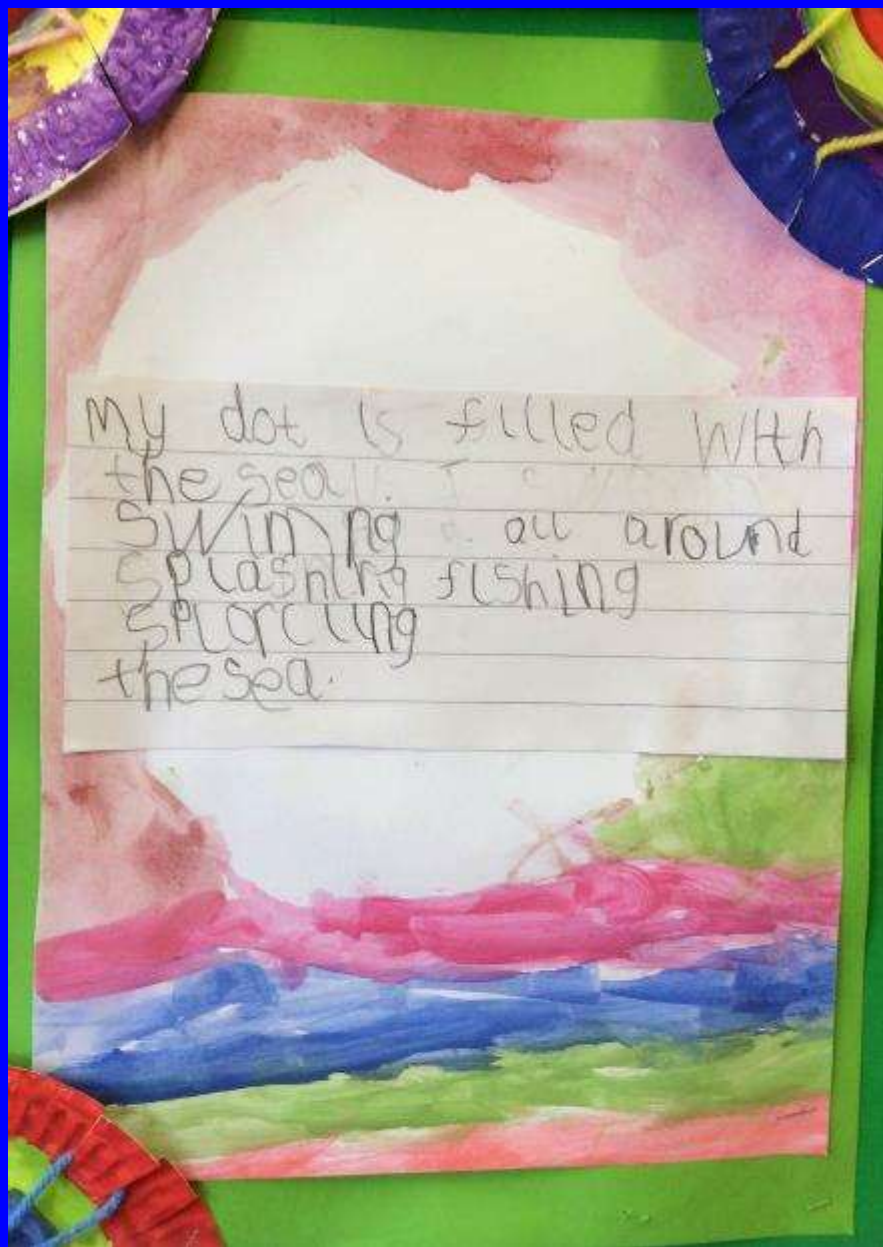
Reception had a fabulous time at Ramsbottom Fire Station!



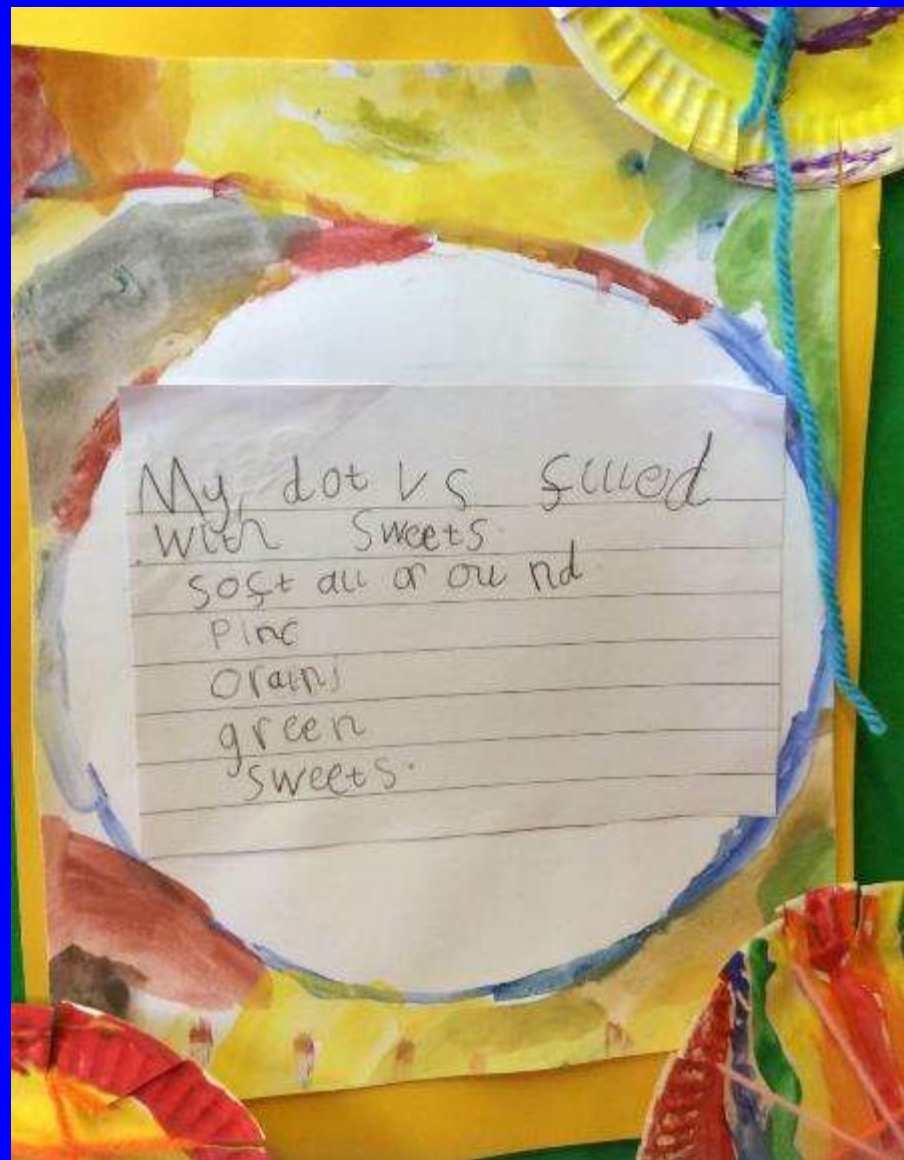
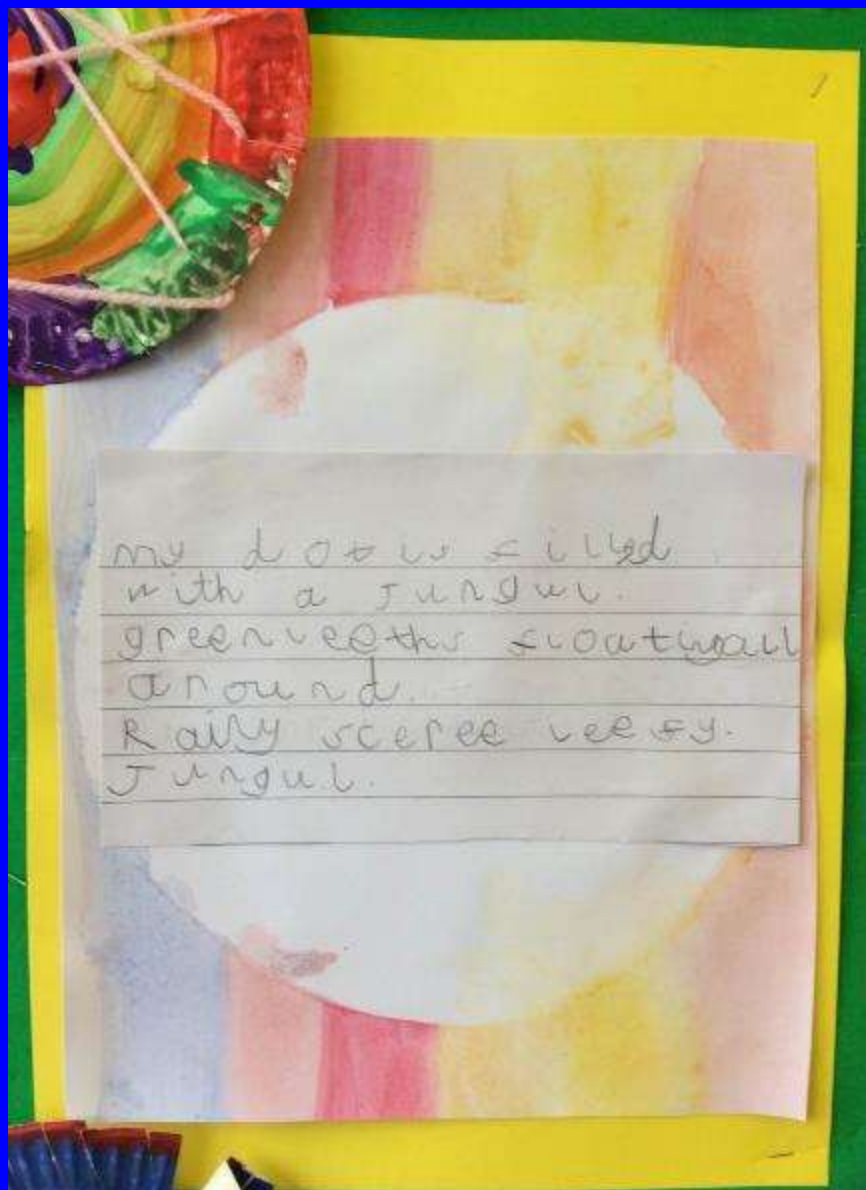
Year 1 read a story called 'The Dot' on Art Day. They created beautiful watercolour dots and weaved dots. They then filled their watercolour dot with a dot poem!

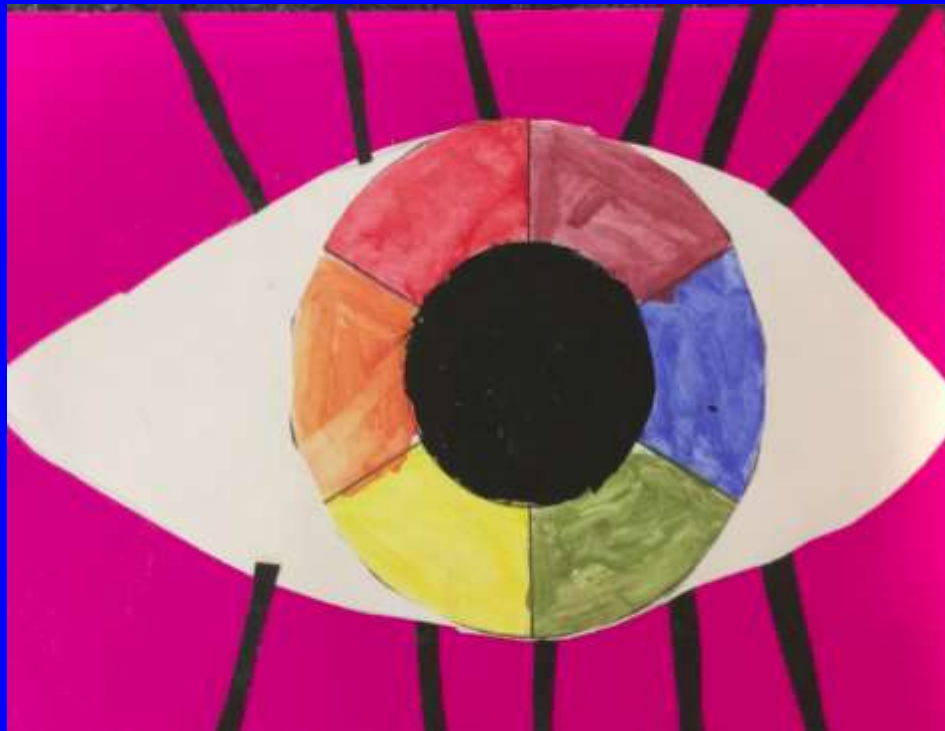

During art day we studied the French-American artist Louise Bourgeois. She created a series of work on spirals. So did we.

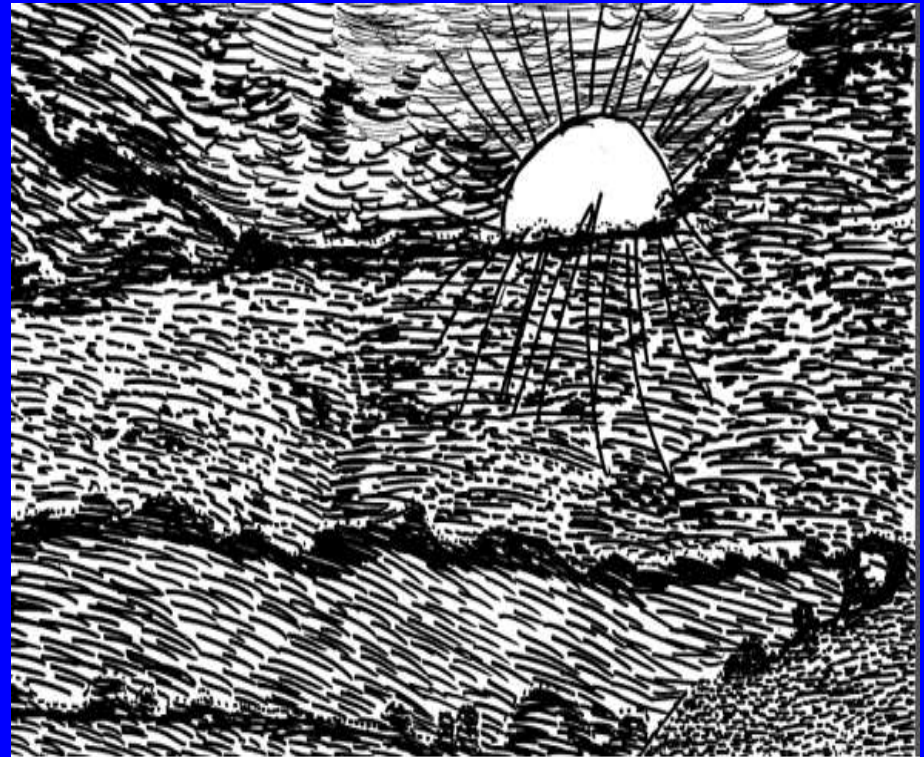
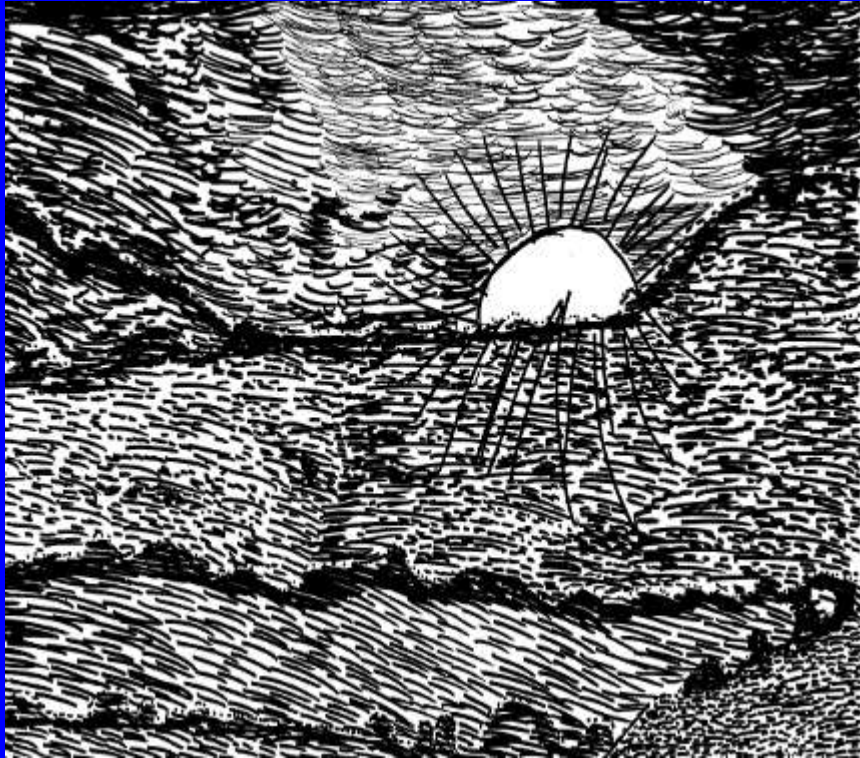
