



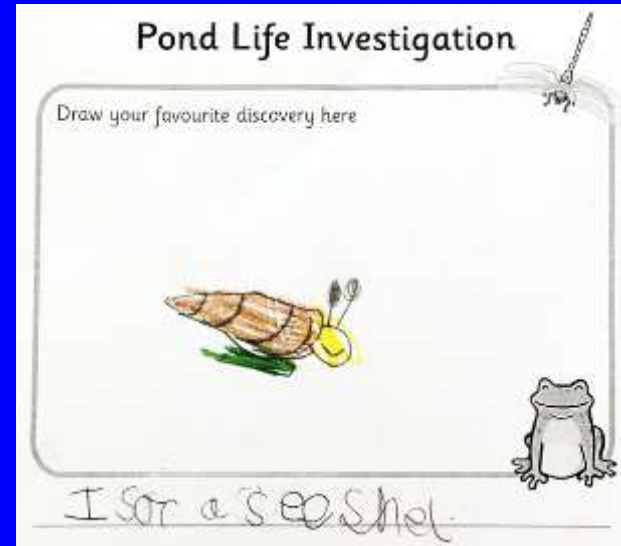
Reception have been pond dipping this week! We found lots of frogspawn and tiny creatures! We brought it back to the classroom to have a closer look at it



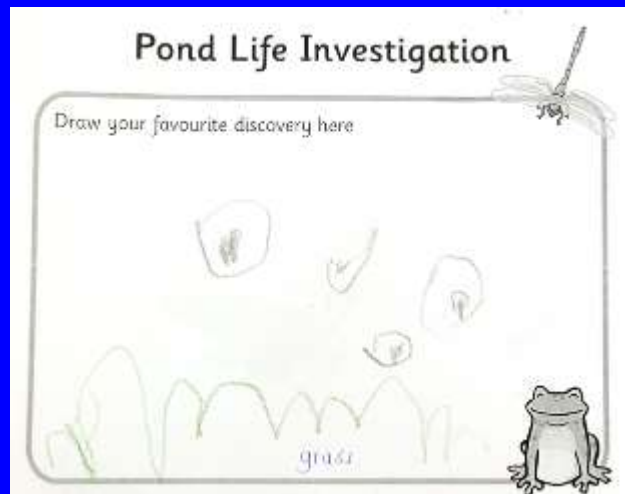

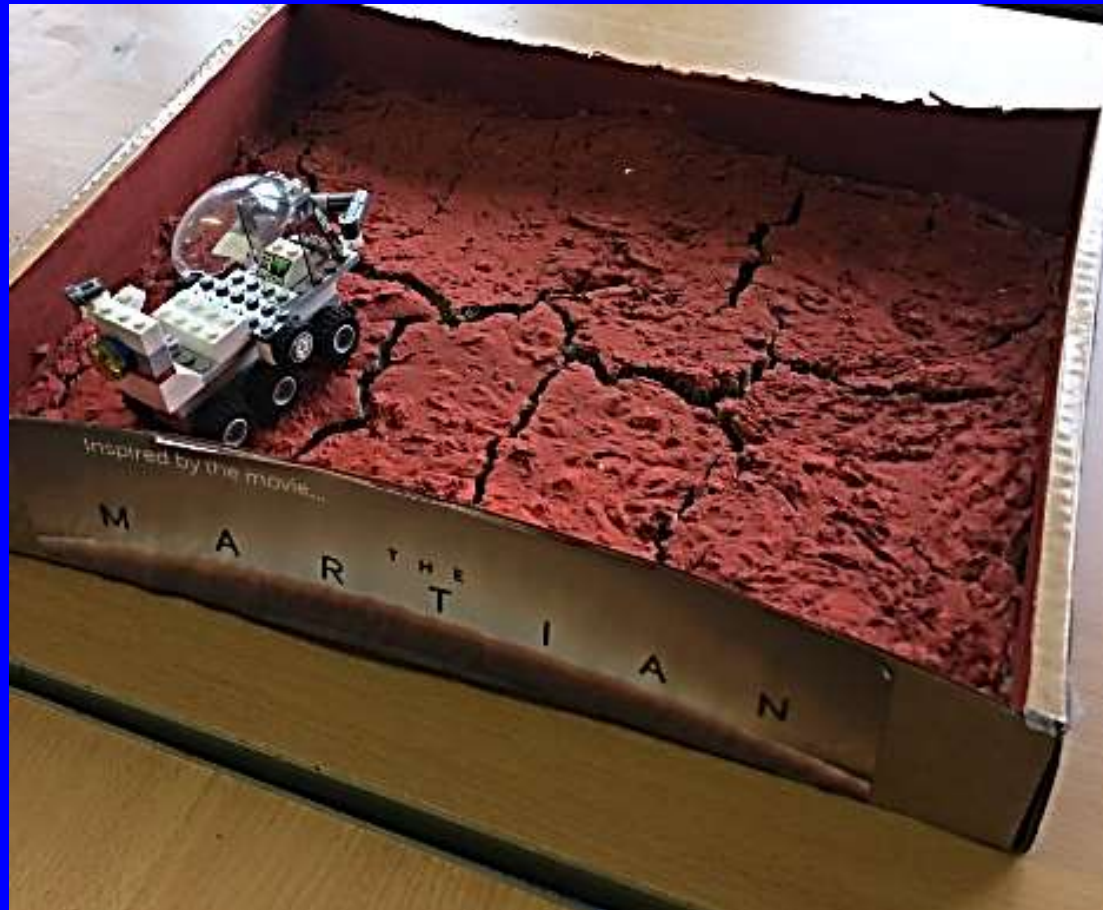
