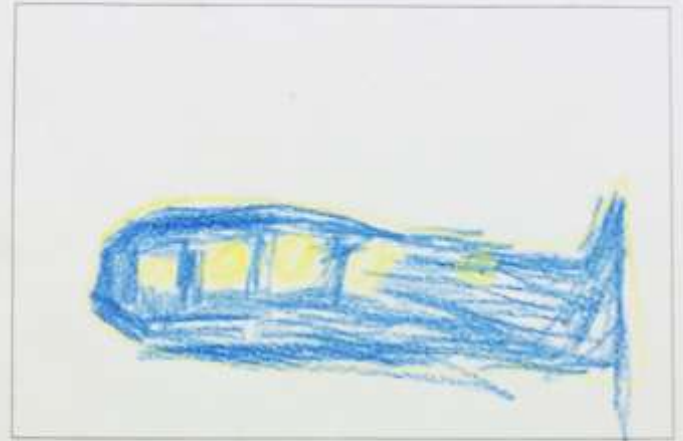

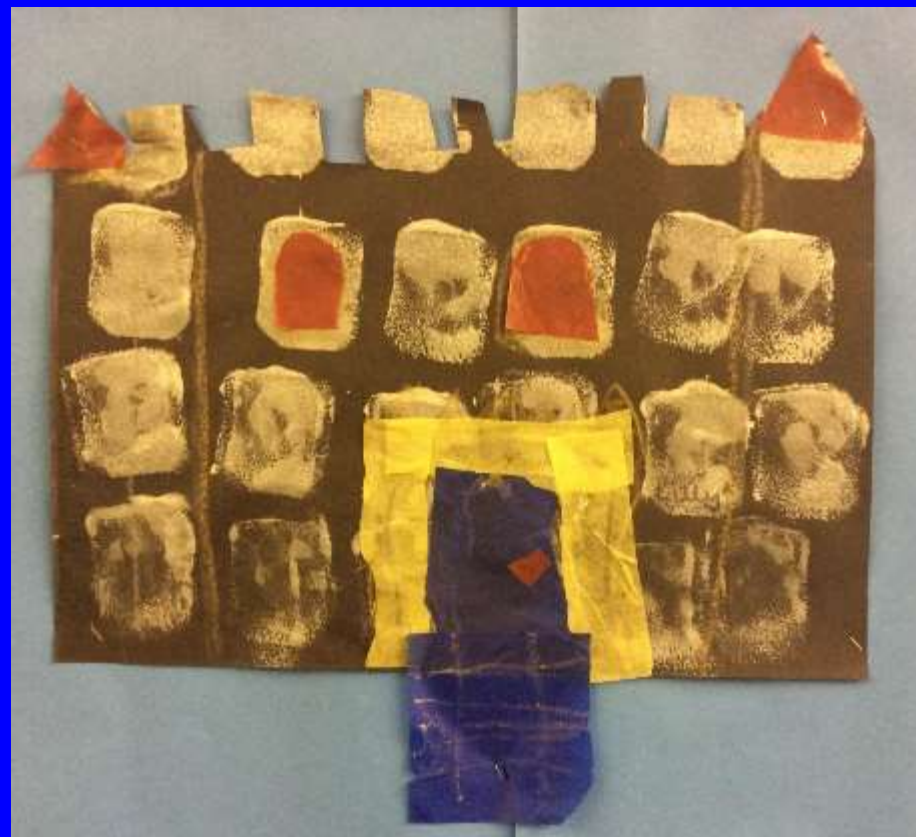

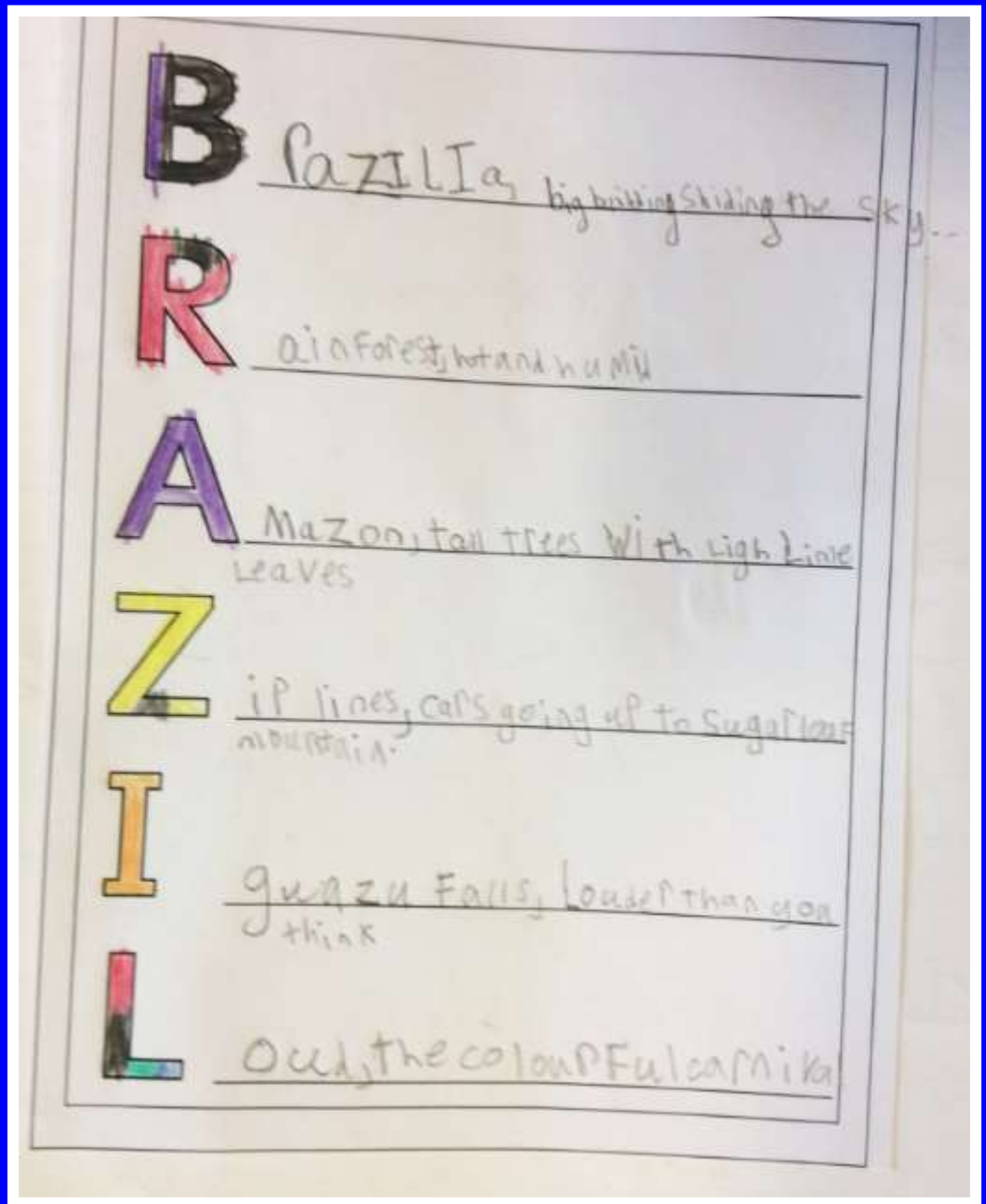
This half-term, in History, we will be learning about explorers. Olivia L created this collage to introduce us to the explorer Christopher Columbus.






