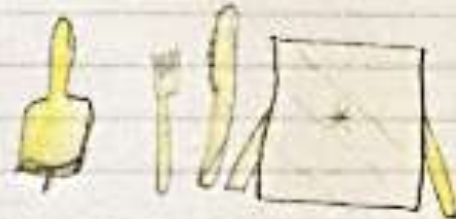

Fu Hao's tomb was one of the the only tombs that hadn't been discovered and robbed. Although it was discovered in 1976 it wasn't robbed.




Use knowledge of parallel lines to work out the perimeter of shapes




The perimeter is the outside of the shape and it means the length of the outside of the shape.

The area is inside the shape and it means the length inside the shape.




