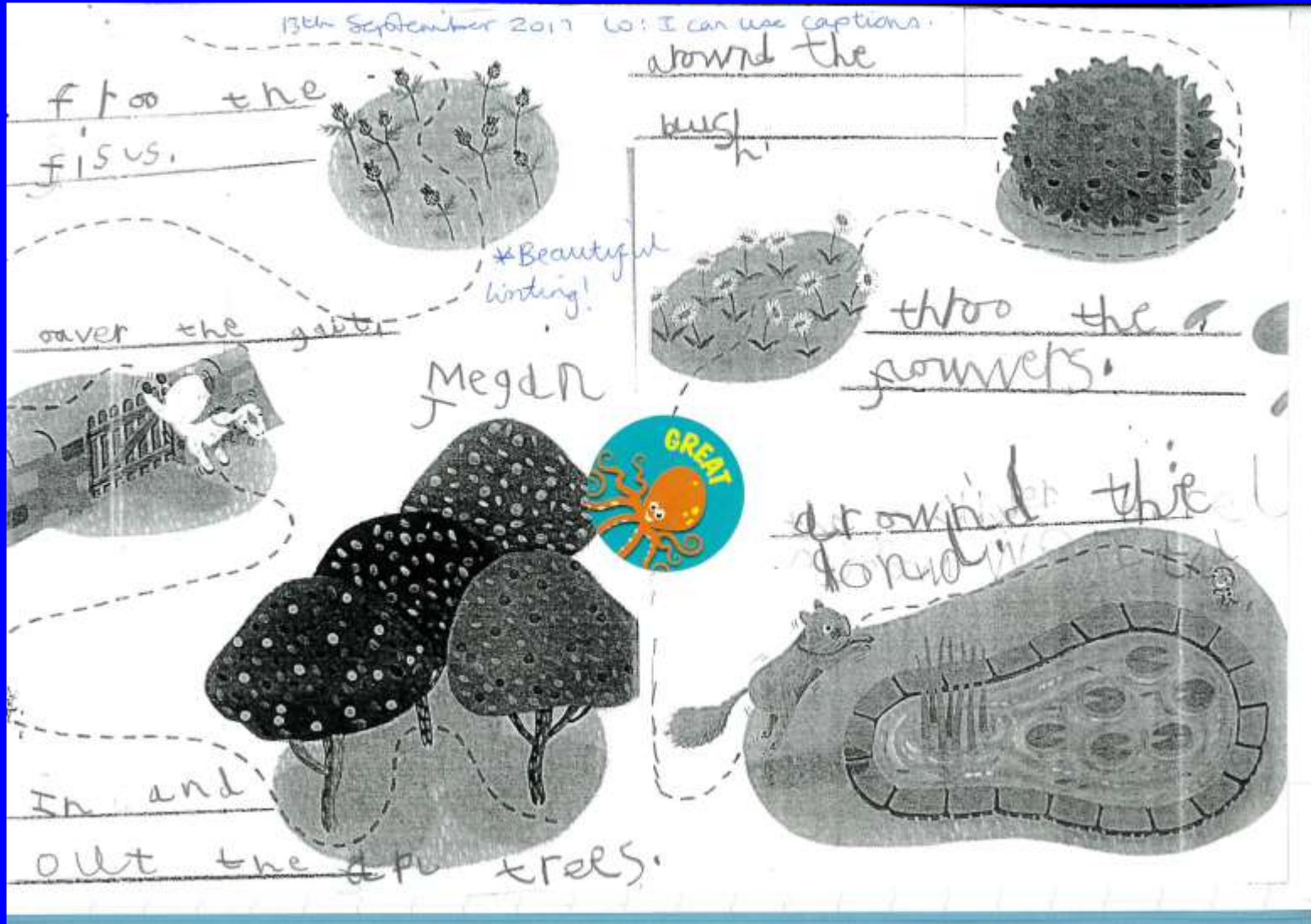


Year 1 - Megan J tried hard to join her handwriting when writing captions this week.
