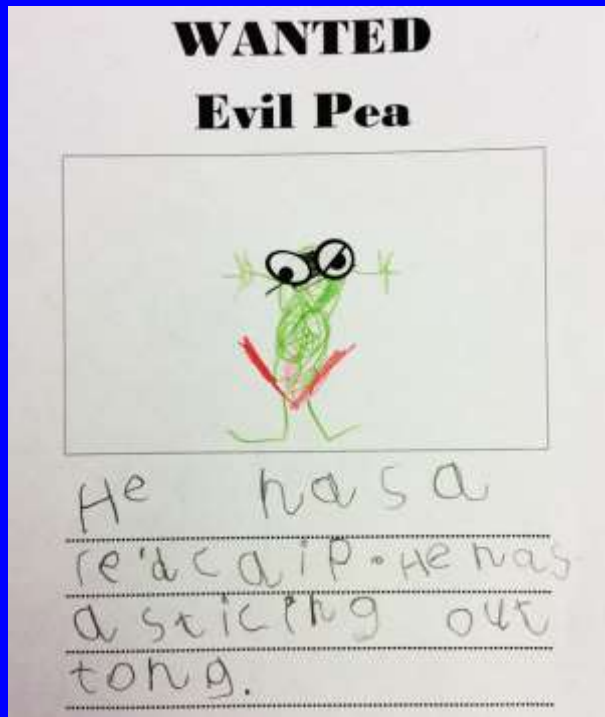


# Year 1 - Milly wrote a great recipe for making owl ice-cream!

- Chocolate treats



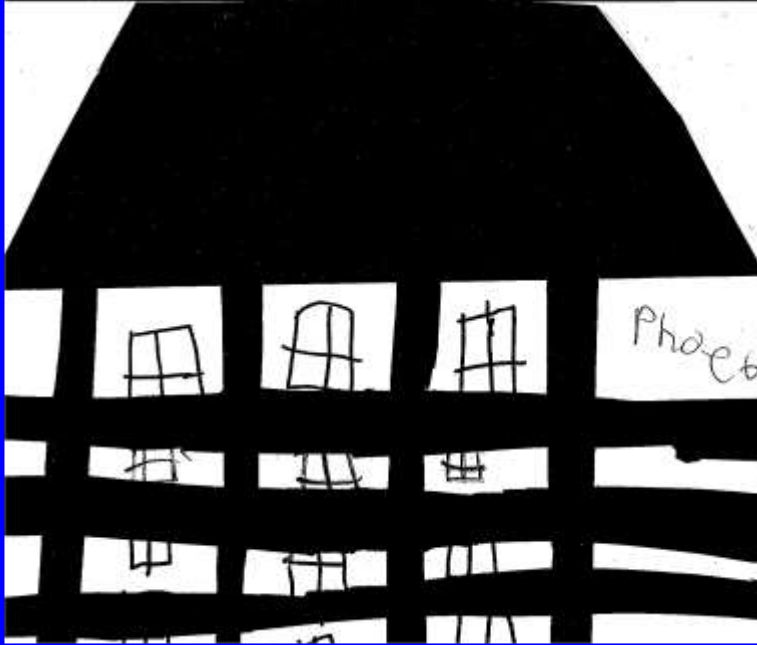
What to do:

It stays the same because the particles don't have room to move



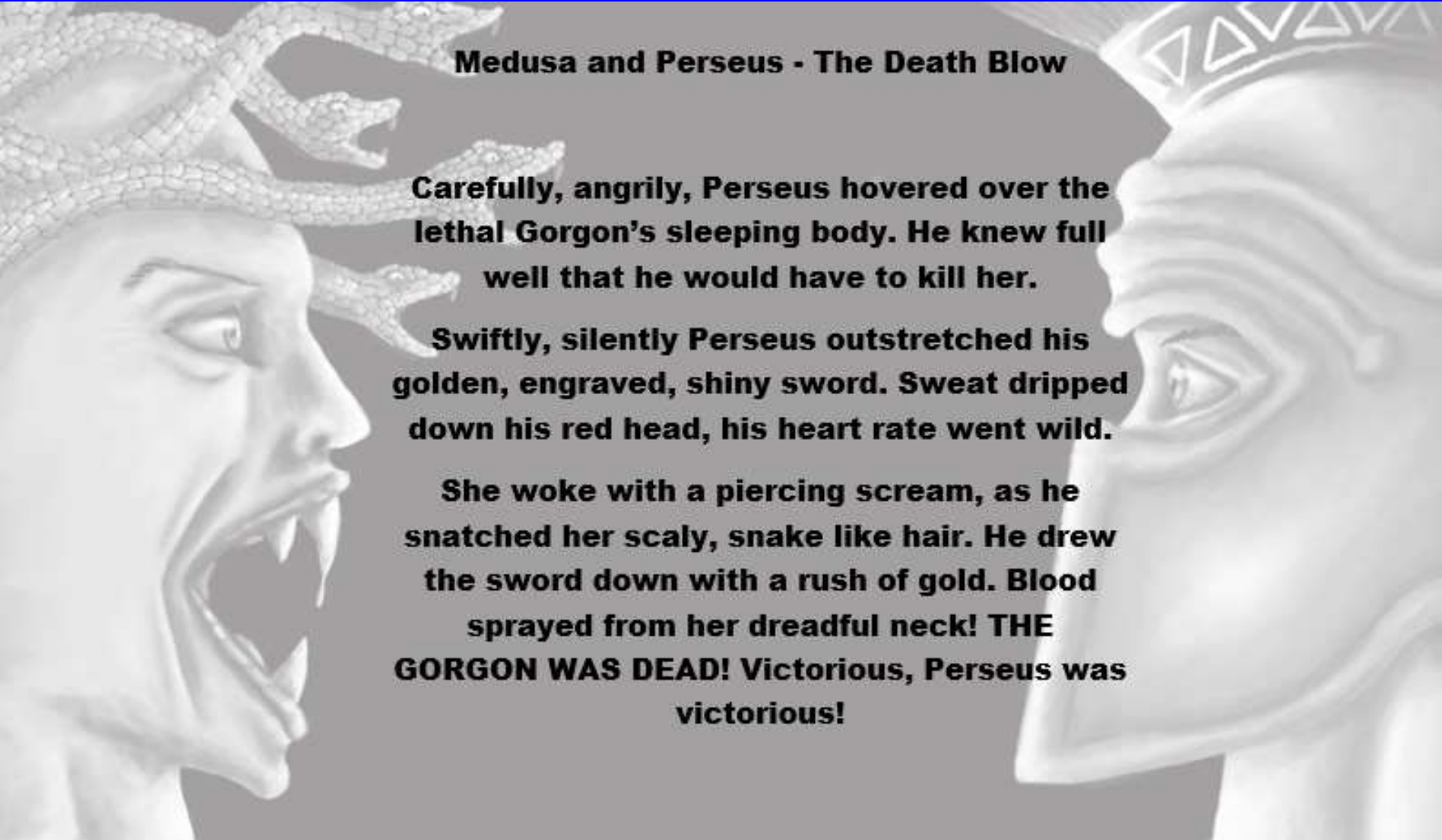
# Year 5- Polly Fordham
