Translucent means SPECIAL LIGHT ONLY! I mean only some light can pass or else it will be transparent.



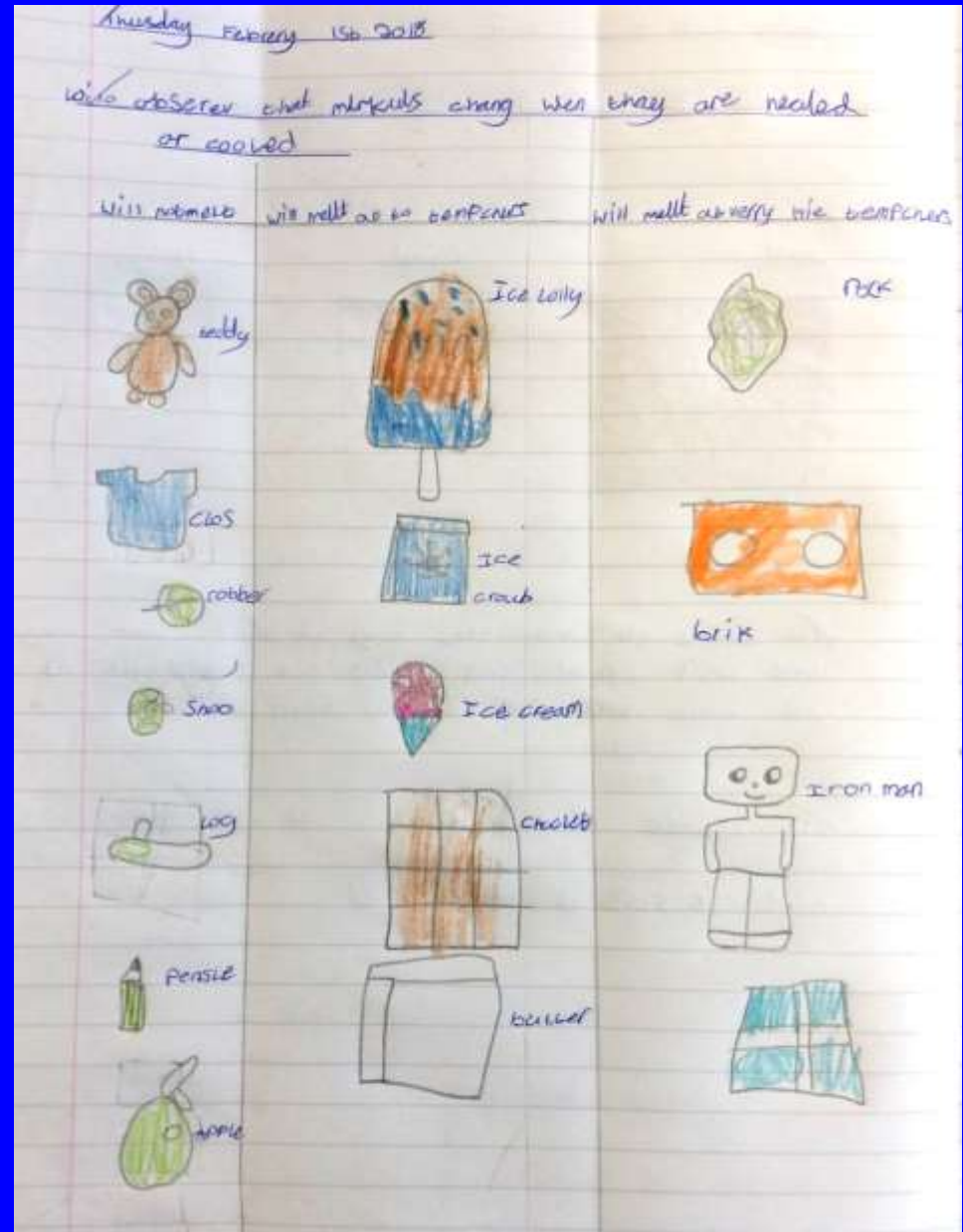
Transparent means ALL LIGHT ALLOWED So all light is allowed when nothing is blocking it.



LO: I can write a flashback.


