The cycle of an erupting volcano.

Volcanic eruptions can be deadly. When the blazing fiery lava is oozing out of the volcano at a high speed, you are sure to want to be far far away. There are thousands of fault lines all around the world, many in America and Eastern Pacific.

Lava

Lava is a liquid rock that builds up in the magma chamber. It becomes lava when it leaves the volcano.

What makes volcanoes erupt?

Volcanoes erupt when the mantle becomes so pressurised that it becomes liquid magma. The liquid escapes through vents in the crust.

What happens when a volcano erupts?

It releases a violent explosion. Clouds of ash and poisonous gas as well as lava fall down to earth.

Volcanoes

Volcanoes are explosive, powerful forces all over the world that ~~do~~ endanger life; they can be found in all continents of the globe. Normally volcanoes are placed by the sea in places like: Eastern Asia, Indonesia and Malaysia.

Volcanic eruptions

Volcanoes can erupt at any time but normally erupt every 10,000 years. Firstly, pressure begins to build in the magma chamber beneath the volcano. Steam and gases escape through the top of the volcano and any side vents. Lava (which is made of liquid rock) flows out of the top and side vents of the volcano. Lava rises from the magma chamber and explodes out of the top. Lava bombs and ash are thrown high into the air. During some eruptions pyroclastic flows of hot rock and ash tumble down the side of the volcano. After that, lava cools and forms new rock formations. Finally, pressure decreases and the volcano returns to an inactive state.

How they are formed

They are formed when magma breaks through small cracks or weaknesses in the earth and when the lava cools and turns into rock and builds up into a volcano.

Types of volcanoes

There are three different of volcanoes: active, dormant and extinct. Active = has erupted in the past 10,000 years and it will probably erupt again. Dormant = not erupted in the past 10,000 years but think it will erupt again. Extinct = not erupted in 10,000 and don't think it will erupt ever again.
