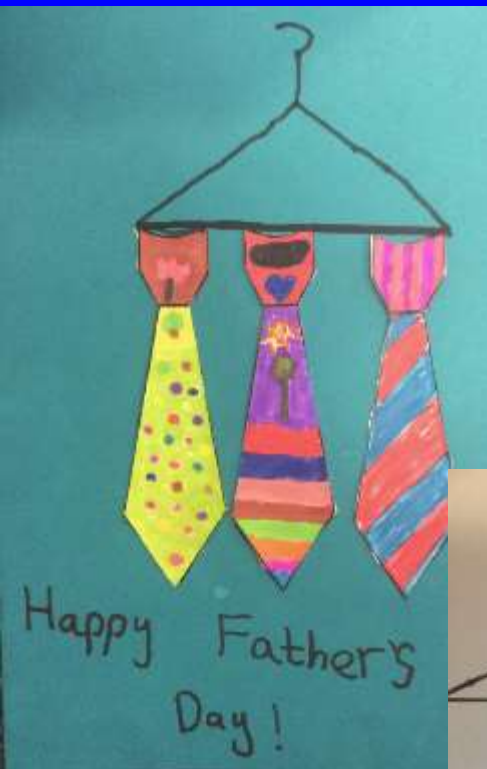
Year 1 have been using freeze frames to retell traditional tales, they all worked as a team and wrote brilliant speech bubbles and captions

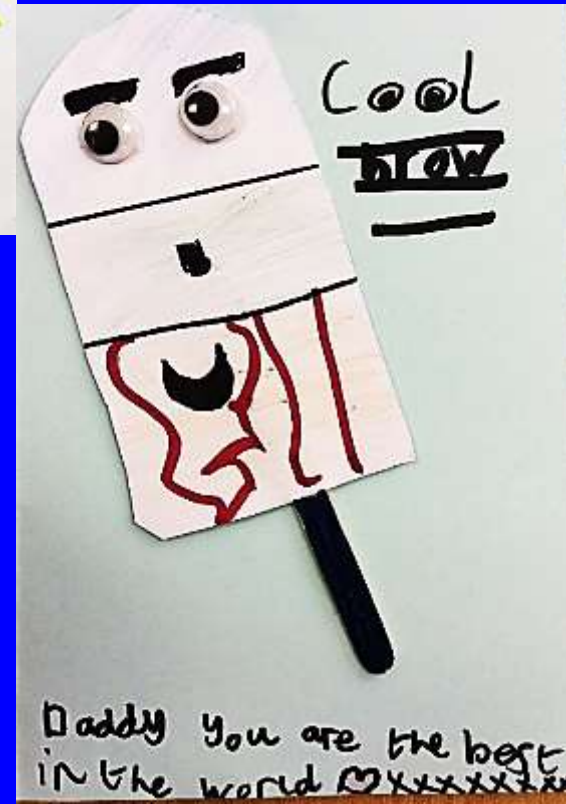
